

Seven Ways to Delay Your Financial Aid

1. Do not apply for Financial Aid in a timely manner or complete the proper application. Students need to submit the [FAFSA](#) (or if you are only interested in state aid, you may submit the [CAFAPP](#) instead) at least 4 weeks before the Financial Aid Priority Deadline and any other requested documents prior to the Financial Aid Priority Deadline (view [Schedules & Calendars](#))
2. Use two different names on documents. When filling out your FAFSA, you must use your legal name
